VPAC Supports UM Student Relief Fund

The COVID-19 Student Relief Fund has been created to provide limited emergency financial support to University of Montevallo students who are unable to meet essential expenses due to a temporary or unexpected hardship caused in the wake of the COVID-19 pandemic.

UM needs our help to meet these urgent needs for items like food, medicine, and other necessities.
