 - 1. Funds2Org will send us boxes, marketing materials to post on Facebook, around Montevallo, and bags for collection.
 - 2. They will give us 40¢ per pound of shoes.
 - 3. Every 25 pairs of shoes collected will be put into one big bag. They would like us to try to collect 100 bags (2,500 pairs of shoes).
 - 4. If we do not reach that goal in 60 days, we will need to pay an \$89 freight fee to ship the shoes to them.
 - 5. We will need a place to store all of these shoes. Is there anyone in the area who could provide the equivalent of a garage or a room?
 - 6. We will probably need to check the boxes once a week. I am willing to make the drive from Atlanta to check and pick up shoes once or twice, but I'll need volunteers to help out on other weeks, as this drive can last 60 days.
 - 7. We are not limited to the collection boxes being in Montevallo. ANYONE can have a box set up at their office with their permission. So, I'd suggest if you work at a gym or large building, ask if you are allowed to place a box outside.
 - What do you think? 100 big bags= \$1000 raised.
 - Concerns expressed:
 - Kay suggests: Taking a temperature check at the reunion business meeting to see if we have people who would be willing to volunteer for a certain number of bags.

 - Destiny and Robby lead the club's Administration side, which is held accountable for the Advancement office and manages all finances for the club.
 - Carlton and I work on the Operations side, which is held accountable to the UMNAA and Alumni Affairs office and manages all operations of the group.
 - The other volunteers who have given their time and talent are joining quarterly conference calls to plan and prepare for all our events and projects. Please come up and stay on the stage when your name is called. General UMNAA Reminders

We as a side have not been as represented as we could be, and would like to be moving forward. We will start sending out reminders about these awards and when they are due for submission. Please be thinking of your fellow Purple alumni and who you think should be nominated for the work they are doing in their communities, professional lives, and the greater Montevallo community. We have a lot of amazing alumni and we need to support and uplift the great work being done.
- o Decades Reunion This evening, \$15 at the door at the new Center for Fine Arts.

VPAC Finances (Robby)

- o Current Financial Status: as of 02/2/2022: \$3,159.18
 - What does it mean to be financially independent and why is that important? Thanks to the donations we receive during CN along with our monthly sustaining donors we can fund all of our initiatives 100% independently of the University of Montevallo National Alumni Association. This means that we have control over our budget and that we can respond to the needs of UM in real-time, versus having to wait to raise funds to help. Some examples of the things we have done in recent years because of this are: providing funds to the Student Relief Fund, the Student Food Pantry, sending gift packages to students that are quarantined due to COVID, and supporting the UM Emergency Student Relief Fund. We also use our budget to fund initiatives that are important to our members such as the College Night Endowment Fund and the Vintage Voyage designated driving program.

■ Typical operating costs annually: \$700

Vintage Voyage: \$400

• VPAC Brunch: \$300

■ That means our balance after college night expenses will be: \$2,459.18

■ What it means to be a "Scalable Alumni Club" is that it can adapt based on the needs of the individual year. We just focus on the things that we do to support our mission which are the College Night Endowment Fund, the Vintage Voyage

- designated driving program, supporting the student food bank, and meeting any other needs of the University.
- Any other projects/activities/events will only be conducted if there is a volunteer that steps forward to lead the requested initiative.

Impact of the Vintage Purples Alumni Club (Destiny)

- o Three Events this Year: CN Revue Ice Cream Social, Alumni dinner, and homecoming brunch are free events for families and prospective students while networking with active students who will be entering the workforce soon. (Note all the official events are free, non-admission events that are also alcohol-free and family-friendly).
 - Ice Cream Social served as a recruiting event for current students to the game of college night and a networking event for current students to connect with alumni.
 - Alumni Dinner We fed around 100 active Purples including the cast and crew and were given a preview of the show.
 - We have pledged an additional \$5,000 to the CN Endowment fund and have already made a \$500 pledge payment.
 - \$500 Donation to the Falcon Food Pantry

Fundraising (Kay)

- o Update on Endowment (\$9,412 paid toward \$10k pledge)
 - We have a balance of \$588 remaining on our pledge balance.
 - The CN Endowment: \$100,000 makes sure the CN game is provided \$4,000 a year for things that are needed, such as new cheerleader uniforms, new athletic gear, replacement of Palmer technical needs for the game of College Night, safety lights for the side spaces, new tools for the sides, and painting supplies.
 - Ideally, once we meet our pledge commitment of \$10k, which with your help this weekend we can meet, we would like to extend our pledge to \$25k within 10 years. The gifts that our membership bestows every year for this tradition we love will more than meet this commitment in that time.

o How can you contribute?

We need your dedication today through a one-time donation or more importantly an impactful long sustaining gift that you can set up customized for what works best for you and your household. - Recap: This is for actives Saturday at SAC before Basketball Game
- Question: Did the Old Gold alumni club cover half the cost of the coffee? I know we absorbed the cost of the cups, cold coffee, and creamers.
 - o Catherine got coffee for free, but we had already purchased five boxes of coffee.

- Lessons for 2024:

Basketball Game - Group Discussion

- The game was played at 10:30 AM in the SAC, and the tailgate was supposed to be from 10:30 AM 1 PM on the "creek side" of the SAC by the intramural fields. The rain forced people inside, and there wasn't much of a tailgate; those that did tailgate were golds, and most purples watched the game.
