

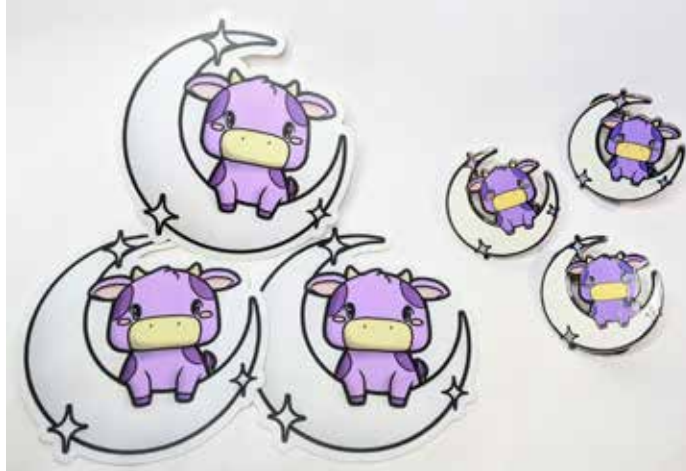

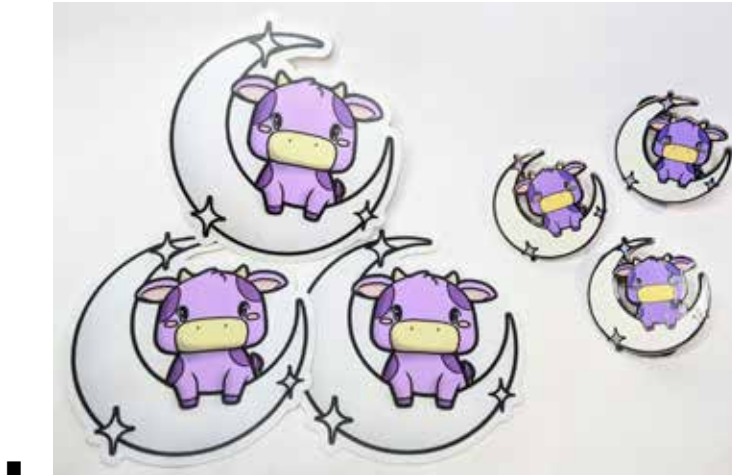

● VPAC Finances - Robby

- Current Financial Status: as of 2/7/2021: \$3972.87 - Estimated total minus the expense for student care packages. The university's new donation system Online Express which it used to be CashNet express. Now it will process donations on the 15th of the month. No new updates to total until post 2/15.

- Robby: The university has switched to using Online Express (the old system was CashNet). All but one sustaining donor has moved to the new system and they have been contacted about transitioning over.

There was an issue last year where we saw monthly donations not showing up. On the last statement, I received from UM those donations appeared on 12/31/2020. Greg Lee of the alumni board has been made aware of this as well as Jacob Gordon and Jennifer Gowin at UM. I will continue to monitor our statements for any discrepancies like we saw last year in account reporting and communicate any issues to UM.

- Robby: Emailed Libby and Kiwi with updated FY2021 list of donors and indicated which are monthly sustaining donors. This needs to be updated on both the vintagepurples.com website as well as in the upcoming CowTale Quarterly.
- Robby: I sent all the thank you cards! That's someone else's job next year.
- Kay: How do we communicate the correct page to donate via the UM website that requires that you go to the "Traditions" fund?
- Robby: Update website; make social media posts, and put something in the CTQ letting people know how to designate donations for VPAC

- Update on Endowment (\$7k paid toward \$10k pledge)

- We will be transferring \$1,500 (or more) toward our pledge the week of College Night and we'll then share an updated fundraising thermometer with the group. - Tiffany is the Director of Alumni Affairs, a position she has held since 2019. Tiffany completed her undergrad at UM in 2000 and went on to earn her MBA at Montevallo in 2013. While at UM she participated in College Night as a member of the Gold Side and served as a student employee in the public relations office. Since graduation, she has served the university in many capacities including graphic design, marketing, communications, adjunct professor, and a number of other roles. She has been a champion of the Vintage Purple Alumni Club since its inception and we would like to welcome her as a guest during our reunion.

- **Introduction of Greg Lee (Kay) -**

- Greg serves on the Board of Directors in the role of VP of Alumni Clubs. He is charged with recruiting volunteers for new alumni clubs, assisting club leaders in organizing new clubs, assist club leaders in the planning of club events as needed, and holding alumni club leadership calls when needed. Welcome, Greg!

- Speaking of the UMNAA, I would like to thank all of those who attended the Alumni Association luncheon earlier today. It is important to have the representation of our alumni club.

- **VPAC Finances (Robby)**

- Current Financial Status: as of 03/12/2021:
 - What does it mean to be financially independent and why that is important? Thanks to the donations we receive during CN along with our monthly sustaining donors we are able to fund all of our initiatives 100% independently of the University of Montevallo National Alumni Association. This means that we have control over our budget and that we can respond to the needs of UM in real-time versus having to wait to raise funds to help. Some examples of the

things we have done this year because of that is providing funds to the Student Relief Fund, the Student Food Pantry, sending gift packages to students that are quarantined due to COVID, and supporting the UM Emergency Student Relief Fund. We also use our budget to fund initiatives that are important to our members such as the College Night Endowment Fund and the Vintage Voyage designated driving program.

- Typical operating costs annually in a non-virtual world: \$600
 - Vintage Voyage: \$300
 - VPAC Brunch: \$300
 - That means our current balance is \$1,120.34
 - What it means to be a “Scalable Alumni Club” that can adapt based on the needs of the individual year. We just focus on the things that we do to support our mission which are the College Night Endowment Fund, the Vintage Voyage designated driving program, supporting the student food bank, and meeting any other needs of the University.
 - Any other projects/activities/events will only be conducted if there is a volunteer that steps forward to lead the requested initiative.
- **Impact of the Vintage Purples Alumni Club (Destiny or Robby)**
 - Three events a year: Thanksgiving dinner, alumni dinner, homecoming brunch - free events for families and prospective students while networking with active students who will be entering the workforce soon. (note - all the official events are free, non-admission events that are also alcohol-free and family-friendly)
 - Pivoting in the midst of a global pandemic looked like this:
 - Virtual Purple Love-In with facilitated speakers on “How to Human Through 2020”
 - \$1,500 donation to the UM Emergency Student Relief Fund
 - \$250 donation of items for the Student Quarantine care packages for isolated students that are in a room in Ramsay for 14 days waiting out their quarantine.
 - 17th Annual Alumni Dinner - we weren’t there in person but we still fed the cast and crew. Due to the shows being a combined effort between Purples and Golds this marked the first year that we fed both sides.
 - \$500 Donation to the Student food bank
 - \$2,162 donated this year toward our pledge to the College Night Endowment making a total of \$9,162 raised toward our \$10,000 pledge for the Trumbauer Circle of Giving.

- A group of Vintage Purple volunteers put together a special arrangement of our beloved side song. During this year when we've all been stuck at home and away from our friends and families we recorded the song that is so very close to our hearts. Through time given by volunteers this song was edited together to show that A United Circle is a United Side even if we are kept apart by physical limitations. They hope you enjoy watching and singing along to it as much as they did putting it together.
 - Tonight's Virtual Homecoming event and game night
- Needless to say, things have changed a lot from when the idea for Vintage Purples was first created in 1999, hosted the first homecoming brunch in 2002, then became an officially recognized alumni club in 2014. We are so grateful to all those Vintage Purples who have invested their time, talent and treasure over the years, thank you.
- **Fundraising (Robby/Carlton?)**
 - Update on Endowment (\$9,162 paid toward \$10k pledge)
 - We have a balance of \$838 remaining on our pledge balance.
 - The CN Endowment: \$100,000 makes sure the CN game is provided \$4,000 a year for things that are needed such as new cheerleader uniforms, new athletic gear, replacement of Palmer technical needs for the game of College Night, safety lights for the side spaces, new tools for the sides and painting supplies.
